- Not hold certain types of prohibited State or Federal employment.

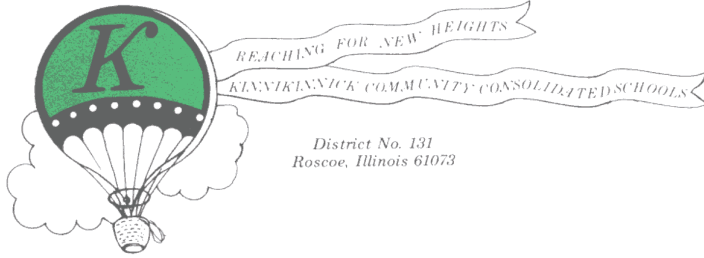
