We understand that chairing something for the first time can be a little scary for a lot of people. The PTO is here to support you and help you understand what needs to be done. **We are in need of chairpeople for the following programs and events:**

Enrichment Programs: These are after-school programs for our children that allow them to further experience a variety of subjects through hands-on teaching, such as Mad Science, Young Rembrandts, Spanish, etc. We need a person to work with these programs and the schools to organize schedules and enrollment. This does not require a lot of time and much of it can be done from home.

Family Movie Night: We need someone to organize a fun night for families to come and watch a movie. This will require very little time.

Family Reading Night: This is an evening of family fun that over the years has taken on many different forms (e.g., story times, authors speak, character play by student and teachers, etc.). We need a person to chair this event, which can be as simple or elaborate as he/she wants to make it, as long as it has a reading theme.

Historian: We need someone to find current newspaper articles and add them to the district binder. This will take very little time.

Original Art (Kinnikinnick): This activity allows parents to have their children's artwork reproduced into a number of professional, full-color products like cards, magnets, t-shirts, etc. We need someone to coordinate the dates with the art teacher at Kinnikinnick, send in the artwork, distribute the magnets when they come in, keep track of orders, and collect the money. This will take a total of approximately 15 hours. This fundraiser takes place in April.

Spirit Wear: This fundraiser lets us show our school spirit on t-shirts, pants and sweatshirts. We need someone to research and choose a clothing and imprinting company, create a logo (or use a past logo), distribute order forms, collect and compile the orders, work with the imprinter, distribute the finished products, and collect money.

Teacher Appreciation (Kinnikinnick): Each year, during National Teacher Appreciation Week, we thank our teachers for the great job they do. We need someone at Kinnikinnick to meet with the coordinators from the other schools to plan events for the week, purchase foods and decorations and implement whatever activities are planned. This will require you to be at Kinnikinnick for the week of May 7.
