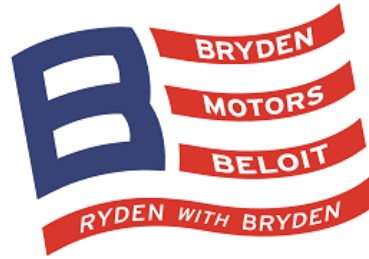

FBI QUALITY

DIGITAL FINGERPRINTING

WHO: Parents and children of all ages are invited to this event. This is one of the top child safety programs in the country & will only be in Beloit for one day.

WHY: So many children are reported missing each year in the USA, thankfully many are found within minutes or hours. Law enforcement officials say that time is critical in the recovery of missing children. One major source of wasted time is the gathering of resources, fingerprints, statistical information and photographs. This can be avoided by providing a pre-made file to the authorities.

WHAT: The Keeping Kids Safe Project has organized this event and will be providing a record for families to take home that will include FBI quality, digital fingerprints. The inkless digital scanner captures high quality fingerprint images that are then printed out and provided to parents for safe-keeping. The only record taken is sent directly home with parents – no information is shared, stored, or data-based. In the case of an emergency parents are then able to turn this record over to authorities anywhere in the world to instantly aid in an investigation, saving critical time and resources.
