<p>Language Arts</p>	<p>Letters: Write letters/your name in the snow. Snap a photo and submit to Google Classroom.</p>	<p>Winter Read Aloud Froggy Builds a Snowman Dictate a story indicating how you would make a snowman. Then have your child illustrate.</p>	<p>Vocabulary: List describing words for snow. Use the 5 senses for ideas. Submit your list to Google Classroom.</p>	<p>What Do We Wear in Winter? This echo book helps to develop vocabulary and sentence/question structure.</p>	<p>Rhyming Words: How many words can you think of that rhyme with snow? Submit your list to Google Classroom.</p>
<p>Math</p>	<p>Counting Snowballs You will need paper, marker, tongs/tweezers and cotton balls.</p>	<p>Shapes: Using marshmallows (snowballs) and toothpicks, make shapes with marshmallows as corners.</p>	<p>Mitten Patterns: Using a variety of mittens or gloves found in your home, make a pattern. Remember, a pattern repeats!</p>	<p>Measuring: Find something you can connect together (ie markers) and measure how deep the snow is.</p>	<p>Spatial Relationships: Draw a snowman or make one outside. When dressing your snowman, put the hat on, next to, behind, etc. the snowman.</p>
<p>Social/ Emotional</p>	<p>Emotions: Watch the movie <i>Frozen</i>. Discuss the emotions that the characters feel throughout the movie. Discuss that emotions change and that all emotions are ok. It is how we handle those emotions that is important.</p>	<p>Emotion Charades: Draw pictures of face emojis with different emotions. Put them into a hat and play a game of charades! Act out the emotion and see if someone can guess it!</p>	<p>Colors & Emotions: What colors come with snow? Snow in the sunlight, in the shadows, at night. How do those colors make you feel? Is it the same as with sand? Paint the colors of snow.</p>	<p>Snuggle Up! Grab a blanket and perhaps your favorite stuffed animal and a family member. Read a story together, look at pictures, or just visit. It does the soul good to snuggle.</p>	<p>Warm Fuzzies: Put on some nice warm slippers, and grab some hot chocolate. Then make a card to share with someone who could use some cheering up.</p>
