6th Grade

Band

Instrumental music that will promote music appreciation and experience. (Students interested in band will need 1 year of band experience or teacher approval.)

Media in the Art

This class focuses on the use of a variety of art mediums including, but not limited to, drawing, painting, sculpture, clay, and graphic arts. (Space is very limited.)

Keyboarding/Cloud Computing and Current Events

Keyboarding: This class focuses on acquiring and developing touch-typing skills.

Cloud Computing: Students will learn three applications in Google Docs: Docs, Sheets, and Slides. (1 semester)

Applied Science and Spanish

Applied Science: The synergistic modules used in this course are computer-based, multimedia content that provides students with hands-on activities that reinforce their understanding of basic concepts in the areas of science, technology, engineering, and math. (1 semester)

Spanish: This course explores basic Spanish vocabulary and culture. It highlights topics as conversational vocabulary, basic greetings, the alphabet, numbers, as well as Spanish culture.
