Roscoe PTO Rules of Conduct

Roscoe PTO wants to provide a safe and positive environment for attendees at all of our events. Roscoe PTO members are parent volunteers in the Kinnikinnick School District. The PTO Board has developed the following rules of conduct which students/guests are expected to adhere to at all events sponsored by Roscoe PTO.

- All students must be accompanied by a guardian unless the event specifies otherwise.
- Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children, family, and guests during PTO events.
- Students will show respect and courtesy to other adults, children, and students at all times.
- Students will show respect for the school property inside and outside of the building.
- There is a "No Tolerance" policy when it comes to physical fighting. Students involved
 will be dismissed from the event. This policy also applies to any student who verbally
 abuses or is disrespectful to any chaperone/volunteer during the event.
- Students will behave in a manner that will not endanger themselves or others.
- Appropriate attire is required. Any student wearing clothing considered offensive will be asked to change or leave.

Roscoe PTO has special privileges provided by the Kinnikinnick School District and any event sponsored by Roscoe PTO is only for students and staff of Kinnikinnick School District. Incidents at events will be reported to school district administration and they will decide if further disciplinary action is needed.
