The Board of Education of District No. 131, Winnebago County, Illinois met in a special session March 10, 2020, at the Kinnikinnick School in Roscoe, Illinois, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

President Young called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Mrs. Freedlund reviewed FOIA requests she received with the Board.


