

2019 Summer School Information

Important Dates:

- The first day of summer school is Monday, June 3rd. Students will receive their class schedules on that first day. The school day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 12:00 p.m.
- Those who are scheduled to attend only a 10:30 class will be notified prior to day one. Otherwise everyone else should report to school at 8:30.
- The last day of summer school will be Friday, June 28th.
- Summer school is every day (Monday - Friday). Progress reports will be sent home with students every Friday of summer school. They must be signed by a parent and returned the following Monday.
- A final report card will be mailed home after the end of summer school.
- Promotion to the next grade will be determined by each student's home district/school principal.

Behavior

- Kinnikinnick School District rules still apply during summer school.
- Students must treat teachers, each other, and school property respectfully.
- No gum chewing is allowed. No electronics are to be used from 8:30 – 12:00 each day.
- No eating or drinking in the school (unless during class if your teacher allows you at a certain time).
- No hall passes are given. Students will be given time between classes to get drinks and use the bathroom.
- Students must comply with the dress code (no hats/hoods worn, at least a cap sleeve on shirts, shorts/skirts beyond fingers, appropriate messages, natural hair colors only, and not distracting).
- Consequences for behavior include demerits, after school detentions, parent phone calls/conferences, suspensions, and dismissal from summer school.
- Demerits will be given for tardies and rule violations. (Consequences: 5 demerits= one 30 min after-school detention, 10 demerits= two detentions, and 15 demerits= three detentions/demerits are totals from all classes)

Grading and Assignments

- The grading scale is (90-100 A, 80-89 B, 70-79 C, 60-69 D, 0-59 F).
- There will be daily work in class, homework, and tests throughout summer school.
- Students will have additional requirements if work is late/missing.
- Students who are absence may be required to stay after school the next day(s) to complete missing work. If the last day is missed, all assignments completed or due that day will be zeros even if that is the first day missed. Students attending both an 8:30 and 10:30 class will also be required to attend a study skills class from 10:00 to 10:30 with Mr. Bergler.
