Technology:

Kinnikinnick provides a 1:1 program where each student has access (PK-3) or is assigned a wireless Chromebook device (4-8). Chromebook care is a priority and is essential to completing tasks in class. **Students in 4th-8th grade are encouraged to keep their assigned Chromebook in a protective case or sleeve to reduce the risk of damage.** There is a fine for lost chargers (\$35) and broken screens (\$100). All other issues are covered by warranty. Due to supply chain delays of Chromebook parts, expect delays in repairs. All students must bring their devices charged and ready for use every day.
